#### What is HOMONYMS?

#### Let's Learn!

When words are spelled the same and sound the same but have different meanings, then they are called **homonyms**. When they are just spelled the same but sound different and have different meanings, then they are **homographs**.

Below are the examples:

**HOMOPHONE –** Same spelling with different Meanings.

#### ■ SIGN

#### Gesture or action.

The teacher gave him the thumbs-up sign.

## Write one's name to identify oneself as the writer or sender.

You forgot to sign the paper.

#### ■ FLY

#### Small flying insect.

I have seen a fly on the table.

#### Move or be hurled quickly through the air.

Let us fly a kite.



■ TIE

### A strip of material worn around the collar

My brother has fixed his tie.

## Achieve the same score or ranking as another competitor or team.

They ended round 2 in a tie.

## ■ WATCH

## A small, portable timepiece

I want buy a black watch.

## To keep in view

I want to watch on TV.

## **TEAR**

## Pull or rip.

I'll tear the white paper.

# This fluid appearing in or flowing from the eye as the result of emotion, especially grief.

She left the room in tears.

## ■ PEACH

## Fruit tree.

I like peach.

## Color

My favourite colour is peach.
