Juveniles and Cybercrime

What is crime?

CRIME is an action or omission that constitutes an offense that may be prosecuted by the state and is punishable by law.

Examples of crime:

Juvenile delinquency (Youth Crime/Teenage Crime)

known as "juvenile offending", is the act of participating in unlawful behaviour as a minor or individual younger than the statutory age of majority.

Cybercrime

also called computer crime, the use of a computer as an instrument to further illegal ends, such as committing fraud, trafficking in child pornography and intellectual property, stealing identities, or violating privacy. Here are the top 5 Popular Cybercrimes:

- **Phishing scam** is the fraudulent attempt to obtain sensitive information or data, such as usernames, passwords and credit card details, by disguising oneself as a trustworthy entity in an electronic communication.
- *Identity Theft scams* the deliberate use of someone else's identity, usually as a method to gain a financial advantage or obtain credit and other benefits in the other person's name, and perhaps to the other person's disadvantage or loss.



Online Harassment being harassed online is a serious form of cyber bullying that is against the law.

Cyber stalking is the use of the Internet or other electronic means to stalk or harass an individual, group, or organization.

Invasion of privacy is a legal term. It is used to describe a circumstance where an individual or organization knowingly intrudes upon a person.
