

- expressing inquiry about the identity, nature, or value of an object or matter, character, nature, occupation, position, or role of a person.

- What is your favorite color?

Who?

Asking information about a person or people.

- Who is your favorite teacher?
- Who is your best friend?
- Who are you?
- Who is on the phone?

When?

at what time or in what situation

- When did you arrive?
- When is your birthday?
- When is the field trip?
- When was the last time you went swimming?
- When do we use an umbrella?

Where?

in or to what place or position.

- Where do you live?
- Where does milk come from?
- Where is your school?
- Where do bats live?
- Where do a king and queen live?

Which

Asks being what one or ones out of a group.

- Which color do you prefer, the red or the green?
- Which of my books would you like to borrow?
- Which one is your favorite dress?
- Which of those houses do you live in?
- Which restaurant shall we go to?

Why?

• for what cause, reason, or purpose

- Why are you so happy?
- Why do we need to study English?
- Why does a giraffe have a long neck?
- Why do children go to school?
- Why do we need to eat healthy foods?

Whose?

of or relating to whom or which especially as possessor or possessors

- Whose bag is this?
- Whose dog is barking outside?
- Whose cellphone keeps ringing?
- Whose painting is this?
- Whose cookies you'll make first, mom?
